

PUBLIC TRANSPORTS

- Ferry boats:

This is the best way to discover Lake Como as the villages are small and parking scarce. Most often the stop is right in the heart of what you want to discover. The best schedule for understanding departure and arrival times is the website [Ferry Boat Schedule](#) as printed schedules can be less accurate. Lastly, keep in mind that the boats in the central lake (Varenna, Bellagio, Menaggio and Cadenabbia) are more frequently serviced and until later in the evening.

- Bus:

Bus service is a great way to move around Lake Como and save some money. If you travel by public transport, you'll be happy to know that bus stops are just outside the main train stations: there will always be a bus that will take you to your destination.

- Train:
